Transition from Reception to Year 1

Our aim is to ensure that the children experience a smooth transition from the Foundation Stage to Key Stage One. The Year 1 curriculum builds upon and extends the experiences that children have had in Reception. Learning through play will continue to be an important part of the school day, and the children will be eased into more formal learning so that they remain motivated, enthused and eager learners.

Included below is some useful information.

- The school gate is open from 8.45 am. Children should enter school as normal where they will be met by a member of the Year 1 team. If you have any concerns or messages please speak to the member of staff at the gate.
- The school day finishes at 3.15pm. We will bring the children to the school gate. Please be patient with us, it takes time to match each child to their parent
- Free fruit is provided in Year 1 but children should bring their water bottles (water only please) which they can access throughout the day and they will change their water regularly.
- Children are expected to read every day, this is part of their homework. Books will be sent home by the end of the first week. Please sign and comment in reading records. Dojos are given as a reward.
- PE days will be Tuesday and Friday, pupils to come to school in PE kits. Please make sure all PE kit is labelled.
- Children are expected to read every day, this is part of their homework. Books will be sent home by the end of the first week. Please sign and comment in reading records. Dojos are given as a reward.
- Homework will be given out weekly on a Friday on the Year 1 Padlet and is expected to be given in the following Friday. This is accessed via the Year 1 page on the website where you can find the link and password. Completed homework can be uploaded to Padlet or returned in their homework book that they can take to and from school.
