



A WOOLLY MAMMOTH


YOU WILL NEED:
Paper, a felt-tip
pen, a pencil
and an eraser




- 1 Using a pencil, for the body and head shape, draw a square with rounded edges and a smaller circle for the head.



- 2 Add a triangle for the trunk shape, and oblongs for the legs and end of the trunk.



- 3 Using a felt-tip pen, carefully add in ears, eyes and tusks, and then draw around the whole shape.




- 4 Erase the sketched pencil lines and add hair, expression lines and toenails.

TOP TIP:

them later.


A PENGUIN



- 1 Using a pencil, for the body and head, draw a square topped with a triangle.



- 2 Add more small triangles to make the beak and flippers.



- 3 Using a felt-tip pen, carefully add in eyes, feet and body. Then draw around the whole shape but remember penguins don't have pointy heads!

- 4 Erase the sketched pencil lines and colour in the dark areas with pen or paint.
