Diary Dates:

We will be celebrating the King's Coronation on **Friday 5th May** with a 'Best of British / Royal' themed dress up day.

We look forward to seeing you for the start of the Summer Term on Monday 17th April.

Statutory Assessments / SATs (Standard Assessment Tests):

- The <u>Year 1 Phonics Screen</u> will take place during the week of <u>Monday 12th June 2023</u>.
- Year 2 SATs will take place during May 2023.
- The <u>Year 4 Multiplication Times Table Check</u> will take place over a <u>three week period from</u> <u>Monday 5th June.</u>
- Due to the additional bank holiday in honour of the Coronation of His Majesty King Charles III, the Year 6 Statutory Assessments dates have changed:
 - Tuesday 9 May: English grammar, punctuation and spelling (GPS) papers 1 (questions) and 2 (spelling)
 - Wednesday 10 May: English reading paper
 - Thursday 11 May: mathematics papers 1 (arithmetic) and 2 (reasoning)
 - Friday 12 May: mathematics paper 3 (reasoning)

Internal School Assessments:

Assessment weeks for all year groups usually take place during the last 3 weeks of each term.




Comic Relief / Disasters Emergency Committee:

There is a child / adult **Book swap** in the school entrance, so if you fancy a new read, please pop in and have a browse.





Our attendance figure for the year has gone up to 95.7% so we're not far off our school target of 96%.

Please note that research shows the link between attainment and attendance: the pupils with the highest attainment at the end of key stage 2 and key stage 4 have higher rates of attendance compared to those with the lowest attainment.

Please note that fines may be issued for holidays taken during term time by the Education Welfare Team. All holiday requests will be referred to the Education Welfare Team as they cannot be recorded as authorised absence unless there are very exceptional circumstances.
