The Event

This is a Staffordshire county final and provides our children with the opportunity to experience competing against children from schools across the whole of Staffordshire. The event itself is often very well-attended and this will be the seventh year that pupils from our school have earned the right to attend and compete. This year, we have three cross country teams taking part and we're very proud of them.

Parents / carers are kindly asked to arrange transport to and from Keele University Sports Centre and are more than welcome to stay and support our children throughout the day. A member of the St John's school staff will be attending the event and will organise the children throughout. We ask that you meet them to the right of the stage in front of the Sports Centre at 09.45 and will remind you closer to the event.

In the past, the course length has been 600m for Y3 children and 800m for Y4 children however I am still awaiting confirmation of this for 2023. The course at Keele has always been a tougher challenge than the Moorside course as it involves different gradients and many more runners, so our children will have to be up for the challenge! Further information regarding exact location and parking places will be issued as soon as I receive further information from the event organiser

Kit

Our children will need to wear their St John's P.E. kit (St John's P.E. t-shirt, hoody, black shorts) and trainers they feel comfortable running in.
