Dear Parents/Carers.

I would like to take this opportunity to welcome you to Year 5.

A bit about me:

I have been teaching at St. John's since November 2020 and I have been teaching for a total of 18 years! I trained in Manchester and began teaching in Stoke on Trent when I qualified. Before becoming a teacher, I was a Police Officer in Newcastle upon Tyne.

Here is some essential information that you need to know.

- When the children arrive, there will be work set for them to complete during registration. They need to be in school promptly so that we can start work on time.
- I also expect them to read in class and at home to extend their reading time. In Year 5, the children will need to be reading longer texts to extend their knowledge and increase their vocabulary acquisition.
- Please make sure that if your child has glasses, they bring them to school. This can significantly hinder their learning if they cannot see properly.
- We have a target of 30 minutes per day.
- Reading records also need to be signed daily by a parent/guardian or child. If a child's reading record is not signed for 3 nights in a row, you will receive a text.
- The school day finishes at 3.30pm. I will dismiss the children from the school yard. As the children are now in Year 5, I will be allowing them out under the premise that they come back to me if they cannot find a parent/guardian. Please make sure you chat with your child about safety and what to do if you are not there.
- Homework will be given out weekly on Fridays and is expected to be given in/completed by the
 following Thursday. It will be posted on Atom Learning. This allows me to keep track of who is
 completing their homework. There will also be homework set on Spelling Shed. Each child will have an
 individual login.
- PE is on a Monday and Friday.
- I will provide the children with all the equipment they will need for the school day. If your child has a pencil case, I will ask them to put it in their tray and they can get it out as and when they need to.
- If you have any questions or concerns, please pop in or call and I will endeavour to speak to you as soon as possible.
