- Year 2 SATs: May / June 2024.
- Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check: the 2-week period from Monday 3 June 2024.
- Year 6 SATs: Monday 13 May to Thursday 16 May 2024.

Internal School Assessments: Assessment weeks for all years take place during the second half of each half term.

Reading at St. John's:

To ensure that pupils develop into competent, confident and fluent readers who love books, every class has:

- Daily phonics / guided reading time which focuses on learning to read.
- Daily 'story time' to encourage reading for pleasure.





Additional Support for Reading:

For those pupils who need some additional support, we have additional phonics sessions, one to one reading, and we look forward to using a new and improved version of the KS2 intervention 'Accelerating Reading' called 'EPATT which will start in the next few weeks. EPATT stands for 'Educational Psychology Assessment Through Teaching' and is an intervention which focuses on mastering fluency in reading.

There is a child / adult **Book Swap** in the school entrance, so if you fancy a new read, please pop in and have a browse.

We are delighted to also be able to offer ELSA support (Emotional Literacy Support Assistant) from Miss Cooper who completed the training last year. ELSA offers support for: friendship, bereavement, anxiety, self-esteem, conflict managing feelings and social skills.
