Communication and Language

Pupils will be able to:

- Enjoy listening to longer stories and can remember much of what happens.
- Start a conversation with an adult or a friend and continue it for many turns.

Literacy

In Literacy, we will be developing our phonological awareness, so we can:

- Spot and suggest rhymes.
- Count and clap syllables in a word.
- Recognise words with the same initial sounds.

Personal Social Emotional Development

We will be focusing on:

- Selecting and using activities and resources, with help when needed. This helps them achieve the goal they have chose, or one which is suggested to them.
- Becoming more outgoing with unfamiliar people, in the safe context of their setting.

Maths

We will be focusing on:

- Describing a familiar route.
- Talk about and explore 2D and 3D shapes using informal and mathematical language: 'sides', 'corners', 'straight', 'flat', 'round'.
- Talk about and identify the patterns around them.

Understanding The World

We will be able to:

- Talk about what they can see, using a wide vocabulary.
- Begins to make sense of their own life-story and family's history.

Physical Development

During PE sessions we will be:

- Continuing to develop their movement, balancing, riding (scooters, trikes and bikes) and ball skills.
- Using large scale muscle movements to wave flags and streamers, paint, and make marks.
- Matching their developing physical skills to tasks and activities in the setting.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be focusing on:

- Taking part in simple pretend play, using an object to represent something else even though they are not similar.
- Creating closed shapes with continuous lines and being to use these shapes to represent objects.
- Listening with increased attention to sounds.
