Use drawing to represent ideas like movement or loud noises. Sing the melodic shape (moving melody, such as up and down, down, and up) of familiar songs. 	<p>Let it Grow!</p>  <p>Celebrations: Pancake Day, Mother's Day, Easter</p>	<p>Physical Development</p> <p>Collaborate with others to manage large items, such as moving a long plank safely, and carrying large, hollow blocks.</p> <p>Dance</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To explore different body parts and how they move. To explore different body parts and how they move and remember and repeat actions. To express and communicate ideas through movement exploring directions and levels. To create movements and adapt and perform simple dance patterns. To copy and repeat actions showing confidence and imagination. To move with control and co-ordination, linking, copying and repeating actions.

Make healthy choices about food, drink, activity and toothbrushing. 	<p>RE</p> <p>Why do Christians put a cross in an Easter Garden?</p> <p>Children will know that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Christians remember Jesus' last week at Easter. Jesus' name means 'He saves.' Christians believe Jesus came to show God's love. Christians try to show love to others. 	<p>Maths</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Know that the last number reached when counting a small set of objects tells you how many there are in total ('cardinal principal'). Experiment with their own symbols and marks as well as numerals. Combine shapes to make new ones – an arch, a bigger triangle etc. Recognise numbers and order 1-10.

Use longer sentences of four to six words. 		<p>Understanding The World</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Plant seeds and care for growing plants. Understand the key features of the life cycle of a plant and animal.
