KS2 SATs Monday 12th May – Thursday 15th May

Dear Parents/Carers,

As you are aware that Year 6 children will be sitting their Standard Assessment Tests (SATs) next week. During this week, your child will be completing a reading, grammar, spelling, arithmetic and two reasoning papers. You will note that there is no writing test as the assessment for this is done based on children's writing across the year.

Timetable:	Monday 12 th May 2025	Grammar & Punctuation test - 45 minutes Spelling Test - 20 minutes
	Tuesday 13 th May 2025	English Reading Test - 60 minutes
	Wednesday 14 th May 2025	Mathematics Arithmetics (Paper 1) - 30 minutes Mathematics Reasoning (Paper 2) - 40 minutes
	Thursday 15 th May 2025	Mathematics Reasoning (Paper 3) - 40 minutes

Assessments will take place in the school hall to enable pupils to have the space and adjustments they need to ensure they're feeling as comfortable as possible. Myself, Mr Redfern, Mrs Hine and Mrs Poynton will be administering the SATs and supporting the children.

Ensure your child gets lots of rest and sleep over the next week to enable them to perform to the best of their ability - please note that smart watches cannot be worn.
