<p>Communication and Language</p> <p>Pupils will be learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Engage in story times.Retell the story, once they have developed a deep familiarity with the text, some as exact repetition and some in their own words.Listen carefully to rhymes and songs, paying attention to how they sound.	<p>Traditional Tales</p> <p>Class Books:</p> <div></div>		<p>Maths</p> <p>In maths, we will be covering the following objectives:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Explore the composition of numbers to 10. Compare length, weight and capacity.Verbally count beyond 20, recognising the pattern of the counting system.Compare quantities up to 10 in different contexts, recognising when one quantity is greater than, less than or the same as the other quantity.
<p>Literacy</p> <p>During literacy lessons, pupils will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Spell words by identifying the sounds and then writing the sounds with letter/s.Demonstrate understanding of what has been read to them by retelling stories and narratives using their own words and recently introduced vocabulary.Write short sentences with words with known letter-sound correspondences (Ph 2-4).	<p>RE</p> <p>What happens in a church?</p> <p>Pupils will learn that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Worship gives time to learn about God, ourselves and others.Worship can take place in different places including school and church.Church is a special building for Christians to worship God.The church school is part of the parish church community.Visitors from the church contribute to school life.Prayer is an important part of worship.		
<p>Understanding The World</p> <p>We will be learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Recognise some environments are different to the one in which they live.Compare and contrast characters from stories, including figures from the past.Materials, including changing materials.	<p>Expressive Arts and Design</p> <p>We will be learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Listen attentively, move to and talk about music, expressing their feelings and responses.	<p>Personal Social Emotional Development</p> <p>We will be focusing on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Expressing feelings and considering the feelings of others.	
		<p>Physical Development</p> <p>We will be learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Further develop and refine a range of ball skills including throwing, catching, kicking, passing, batting and aiming.Develop confidence, competence, precision and accuracy when engaging in activities that involve a ball.
