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Y6 Update – *The Amazing Adventures of Superstan!*

Dear Parents / Carers,

We are on track with our work on our KS2 show this year, which I'm sure you're aware is called 'The Amazing Adventures of Superstan!' and will be working hard to put on the very best show that we can. There will be evening performances on Wednesday 16th and Thursday 17th July, along with an additional afternoon show which will also be on Wednesday 16th July. Ticket information will be issued shortly.

Regarding the performance, below is a list of suggested costumes ideas. We would be very grateful if you could have a look through your wardrobes etc to source something appropriate for your child to wear. All costumes will need to be sent into school in a labelled bag by Thursday 10th July. The suggestions below are a rough guide, however we would be very grateful if you could stick as close to the guidance as you can to help us to create the best on-stage 'look' as we can. **Please do remember to have a good look to see if there's anything at home that you can re-use.** There is absolutely no expectation – and often very little need – to purchase expensive 'fancy-dress' type outfits.

Candy King – An evil play on the 'Willy Wonka' character. Purple suit/suit jacket, waistcoat, purple / black trousers and top hat with a white shirt.



The school will provide the costume for the alternative character of the **Bogeyman**.

Superstan – Superstan must look like a real superhero! The costume should include an eye-mask / cape- and perhaps even a hood and gloves! The school will provide the *anti-gravity pants*!

Stanley Marvel – Stan, as his mortal self, must look as un-superhero-like as possible. A shirt, bow tie / with trousers, trainers and glasses. Greys and browns would be the order of the day (keep it plain).

DC - Must look much more colourful and fun, so try a bright t-shirt, jeans and trainers

Gran / The Crumblies (Frank, Gloria, Bernard) – Old age pensioners...who are training for a marathon! Perhaps brightly coloured shorts/leggings and vests/shirts with accessories such as leg warmers and sweat bands. Glasses and grey wigs would also work (as a bonus – no expectation).



The Mayor of Megaville – Suit (can be just a jacket with black trousers etc) / shirt / tie combo. Suit can be any colour. A hat if possible!



Evil Scientists / Doctors – Lab coat (school to provide), plain coloured t-shirt underneath with black trousers and trainers. Wigs optional!



Curly / Wurly – Plain, white t-shirts with blue / purple trousers.

Max Volume / Sunny Day - Max to wear trousers / suit jacket (any colour) with a shirt and tie. Sunny could be in bright suit or dress (if she has a rain coat and umbrella, that'd be great!) Sunny as the Curator – white shirt and tie, black trousers.

News Reporters (Dan Deadline, Peter, Parker, Clark, Kent) - Black trousers and brightly coloured shirts and ties are simple but effective for the reporters, perhaps with a pair of glasses.

Citizens – Brightly coloured, plain t-shirts and black trousers.

General Commotion / Marines – Khaki green / camouflaged clothing.
