



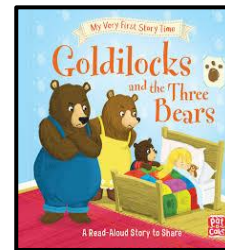
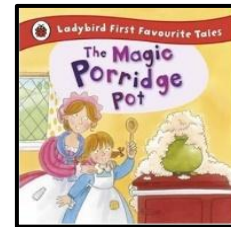
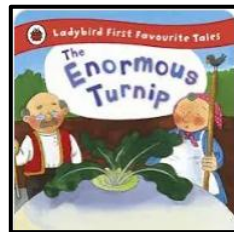
### Communication and Language

Pupils will be learning to:

- Engage in story times.
- Retell the story, once they have developed a deep familiarity with the text, some as exact repetition and some in their own words.
- Listen carefully to rhymes and songs, paying attention to how they sound.

### Literacy

During literacy lessons, pupils will:

- Spell words by identifying the sounds and then writing the sounds with letter/s.
- Demonstrate understanding of what has been read to them by retelling stories and narratives using their own words and recently introduced vocabulary.
- Write short sentences with words with known letter-sound correspondences (Ph 2-4).

### Maths

In maths, we will be covering the following objectives:

- Explore the composition of numbers to 10. Compare length, weight and capacity.
- Verbally count beyond 20, recognising the pattern of the counting system.
- Compare quantities up to 10 in different contexts, recognising when one quantity is greater than, less than or the same as the other quantity.

### RE

What happens in a church?

Pupils will learn that:

- Worship gives time to learn about God, ourselves and others.
- Worship can take place in different places, including school and church.
- Church is a special building for Christians to worship God.
- The church school is part of the parish church community.
- Visitors from the church contribute to school life.
- Prayer is an important part of worship.

### Personal Social Emotional Development

We will be focusing on:

- Expressing feelings and considering the feelings of others.

### Understanding The World

We will be learning to:

- Recognise some environments are different to the one in which they live.
- Compare and contrast characters from stories, including figures from the past.
- Materials, including changing materials.

### Expressive Arts and Design

We will be learning to:

- Listen attentively, move to and talk about music, expressing their feelings and responses.

### Physical Development

We will be learning to:

- Further develop and refine a range of ball skills including throwing, catching, kicking, passing, batting and aiming.
- Develop confidence, competence, precision and accuracy when engaging in activities that involve a ball.
