Grossbusters: The Monster Musical! – Y3, Y4 & Y5

Dear Parents / Carers,

Following the link to the costume guidance letter that was messaged out recently, I'd like to provide more information regarding the important role that our Y3, Y4 and Y5 pupils will be playing in the production of Grossbusters. Whilst we will continue with our usual approach of our Y6 children taking the lead in what is one of their final primary school experiences, our other KS2 classes also play their part. They sing the songs of the show, pop up on stage if given a particular role or even take part in dances.

Some children will have been allocated a specific role to perform or may have lines or dances to learn (this will have been decided upon by their Class Teacher). All children will have learned the songs to the show and will form the chorus. They can dress for the roles given to them or for those allocated to their class. The roles allocated to each year group are outlined below.

We really would appreciate it if as many children as possible could return to school for the evening performances of the show (Tuesday 14th July and Wednesday 15th July) to help to contribute towards the success of the performances. Children can return to school for 5.45pm for a 6pm start.

Year Group Roles

Y3 - The Gloopers – Lime green, plain t-shirts, sunglasses, crazy hair. Below is the visual guidance provided by the show's distributors – please do not feel under pressure to provide a lime green onesie!



Y4 - The Normtroopers– Think 'Men in Black'– a cool look, with black tie, white shirt, sunglasses.



Y5 – Role 1 - The Normaltons – no bright colours! White shirt, black bow tie / tie, knee length shorts / black trousers, round glasses.



Y5 – Role 2 (allocated) - The B.U.M. Brigade - Our members of the Monster Union should look united if possible – plain red t-shirt, black trousers / leggings, monster horns and a furry tail.

Should you have any further questions regarding possible roles given to your child, please contact their Class Teacher with your queries and I'm sure that they will answer them for you.

We hope that you, our brilliant St John's parents, carers and wider family members, will come along to see the show and get involved with the fun. The children and staff always work really hard to put on the best performance that they can.
