Dear Parents/Carers,

I would like to take this opportunity to welcome you to Year 5.

A bit about me:

I have been teaching at St. John's since November 2020 and I have been teaching for 20 years. I trained in Manchester and began teaching in Stoke-on-Trent when I qualified. Before becoming a teacher, I was a Police Officer in Newcastle upon Tyne.

Here is some essential information that you need to know.

- When the children arrive, there will be work set for them to complete during registration. They need to be in school promptly so that we can start work on time.
- I also expect them to read in class and at home to extend their reading time. In Year 5, the children will need to be reading longer texts to extend their knowledge and increase their vocabulary acquisition.
- We have a reading target of 25 minutes per day as a minimum.
- Reading records also need to be signed daily by a parent/guardian or child. If a child's reading record is not signed for 3 nights in a row, you will receive a text.
- **Please make sure that if your child has glasses, they bring them to school. This can significantly hinder their learning if they cannot see properly.**
- The school day finishes at 3.30pm. I will dismiss the children from the side door that we have used in previous years.
- Homework will be given out weekly on Fridays and is expected to be given in/completed by the following Thursday. It will be posted on Atom Learning and SPAG.com. All homework is online. This allows me to keep track of who is completing their homework. Each child will have an individual login which is stuck in their reading diary. There will also be spellings, but these may not fall weekly.
- Any other information you will need about the class is on PADLET. The link to this can be found on the Year 5 class page.
- **PE days are Monday and Friday. Please ensure that your child can remove their own earrings as I am not allowed to do this.**
- I will provide the children with all the equipment they will need for the school day. If your child has a pencil case, I will ask them to put it in their tray and they can get it out as and when they need to.
- If you have any questions or concerns, please pop in or call and I will endeavour to speak to you as soon as possible.
